

HomeTowne Television Terms of Service

This site (the "Site") is owned and operated by Communities on Cable, Inc. dba HomeTowne Television ("HTTV") for your personal entertainment, information, education and communication. Please feel free to browse the Site; however, your access and use of the Site is subject to the following terms of service ("Terms of Service" or "TOS") and all applicable laws. By accessing and browsing the Site, you accept, without limitation or qualification, the Terms of Service.

Restrictions on Use of Materials
